It is a condition of issue of a dairy primary producer's accreditation that the applicant agrees:

1. that sale of all milk and colostrum, intended for human consumption, must only be to an accredited dairy processor
2. to abide by Standard 4.2.4 of the Food Standards Code
3. to pass an annual audit for your approved food safety arrangement
4. to supply annually to the Dairy Authority of South Australia such statistical information as may be required
5. to advise the Dairy Authority of South Australia in writing should any / all accreditees cease dairying, and
6. a dairy processor has the right to refuse to collect a dairy farmer's milk should they deem the product unsafe or unsuitable.

PRIVACY STATEMENT:

The Dairy Authority of South Australia (DASA) collects personal information relating to accredited producers in order to fulfil its requirements under the Primary Produce (Food Safety Schemes) Act 2004 and the Primary Produce (Food Safety Schemes) (Dairy Industry) Regulations 2005.
